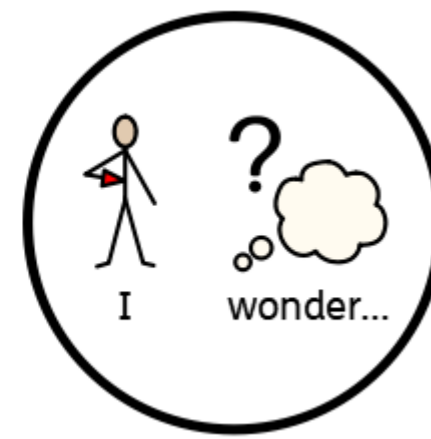
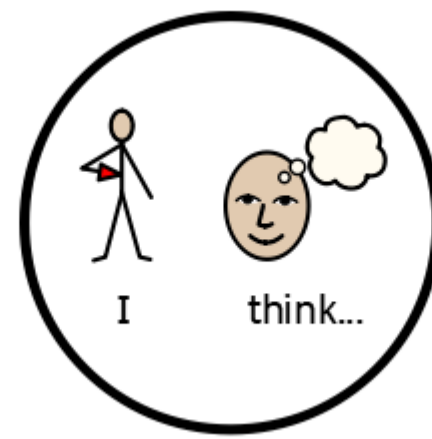
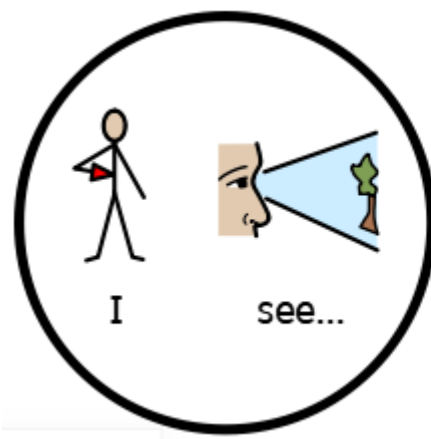


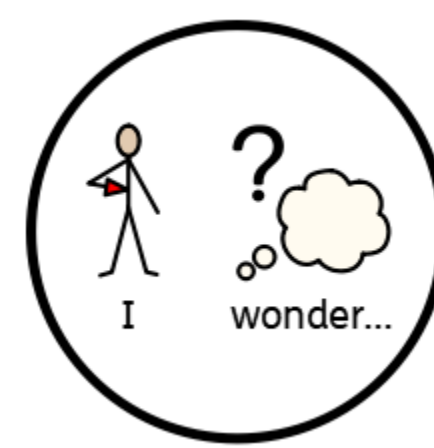
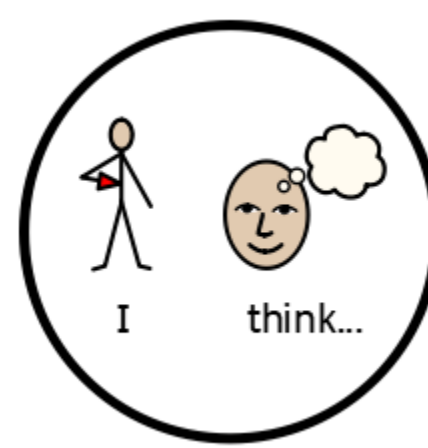
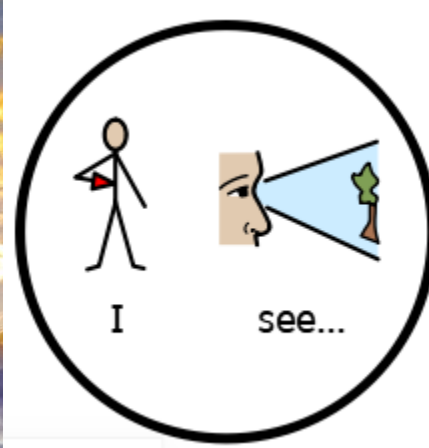
Time to talk
