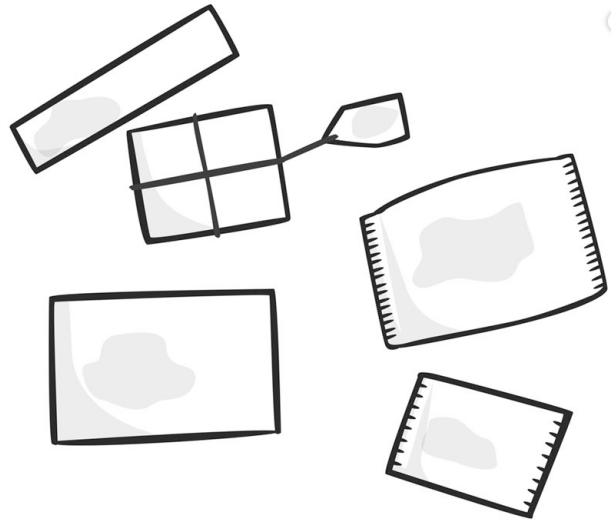
The Lady Artist's



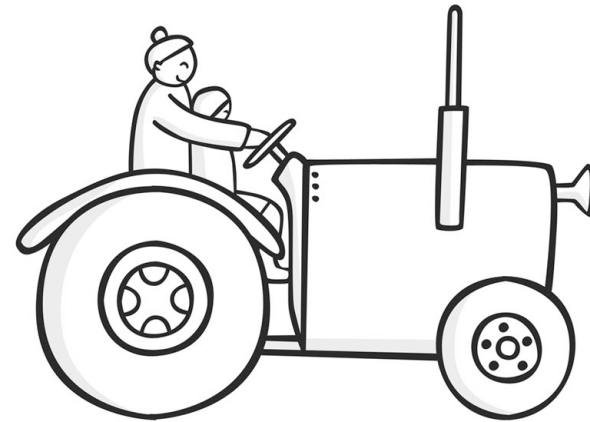
Fishing Hooks



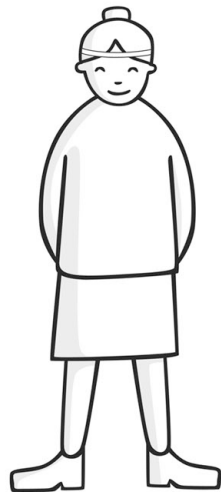
On wednesdays the boat brought the mail.

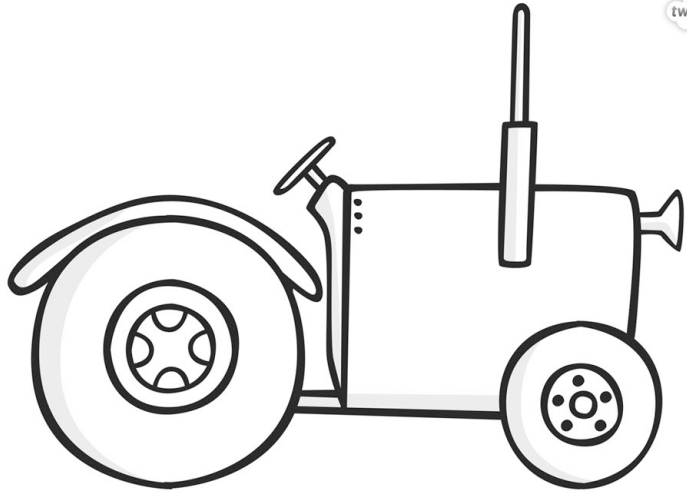

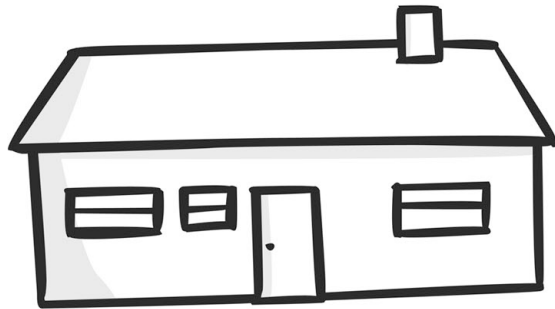

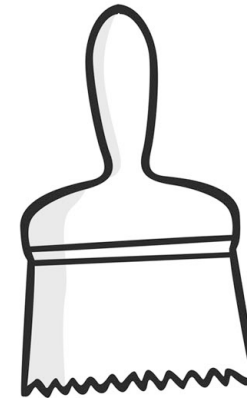

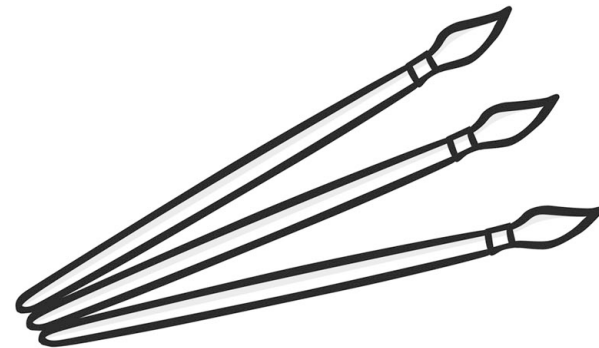

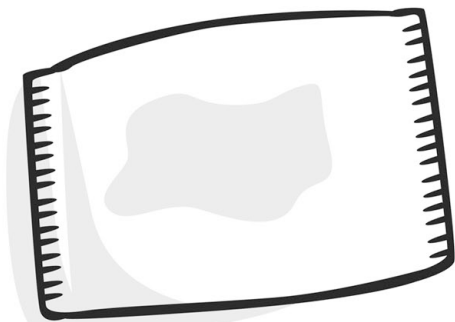
