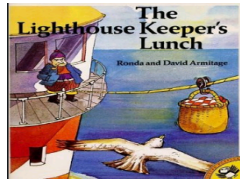


Home Learning Activities Week 3

Research: What is a lighthouse and what do they do?



Design, then make a lighthouse model out of toilet roll tubes and a yogurt pot etc.



Look at the basket in the story and the type of food Mrs Grinling packs for Mr Grinling. Use the healthy food plate to see if they have included all the different varieties of food needed for a balanced diet.



What would you put in your basket? Draw a basket and write/draw all the things you would put in it. Think about a healthy balanced diet.



Have a picnic with your family. Take a picture and upload it on dojo.



Make a pulley system or invent a way that Mr and Mrs Grinling can get Mr Grinling's lunch to the lighthouse without the seagulls eating it.



Mr Grinling has to go to the lighthouse come rain or shine. Can you draw the clothes he would need to take with him on a rainy day?



Hamish the cat felt scared when he had to go in the basket. What could you do to make Hamish feel better? Draw Hamish and write/draw pictures around him that would make him feel better.
