

London Bus Paper Model

You will need:

- London bus template;
- Scissors;
- Glue.

Instructions:

1. First cut out the template along the thick black lines. Make sure you cut down the side of tab 3.



2. Carefully cut out the three parts with the blue highlights in them. You may need to ask an adult to help you with this step.



3. Fold upwards all the lines with a dot and dash (a valley fold). — · — · —

4. Fold downwards all the lines with a dash (a hill fold). — — — — —

5. Take Part A. At the front of the bus, gently push the valley fold inwards to make the corner where the driver would sit.

6. Take Part C and add glue to tab 1 and 2 and to the oblong labelled 'front window'.

7. Put it under the front on the bus where there is a square-shaped hole.

8. Stick tab 1 behind the front of the bus.

9. Push the piece behind the driver's window and stick the 'front window' oblong here.

10. Loop the final piece across the top and stick tab 2 to the front of upstairs part of the bus.

11. Add glue to tab 3 and press firmly to the inside of the bus.



12. Now turn to the back of the bus. Add glue to tab 4 and 5. Press tab 4 to the underside of the back of the bus.
13. Stick tab 5 to the back of the bus to create the open door where people get on and off.
14. Add glue to the tabs numbered 6 to 12 in order and press them firmly in place.
